



World peace day observed at NSU

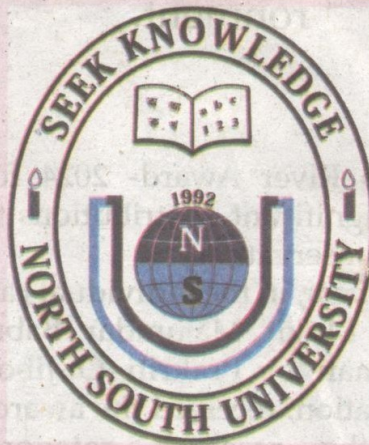
