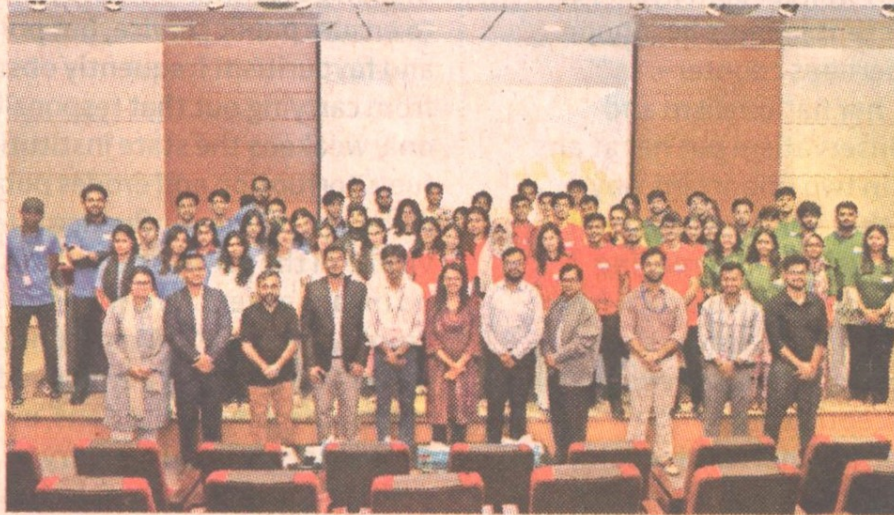




NSU partners with Google, Prothom Alo for digital journalism training



North South University's (NSU) Media, Communication, and Journalism (MCJ) organised a day-long training session on digital journalism sponsored by Google and organised by Prothom Alo.

The session, held on Thursday, is aimed at enhancing participants' AI literacy, information verification skills, and digital reporting capabilities, according to a press release. Professor Dr. Md.
