NSU top private varsity

North South University (NSU) has been ranked 149th in the QS Asia University Rankings 2026, published on Tuesday, says a statement.

With this result, NSU has once again secured its position as the number one private university in Bangladesh and the second-best university in the country overall, including both public and private institutions.

NSU's advancement from 155th last year to 149th this year marks a milestone – entering the Top 150 in Asia for the first time.

Southern Asia, NSU has been ranked 18th, standing just behind the University of Dhaka (17th).

This recognition further highlights NSU's growing regional and international prominence.
