



NSU signs memos with ARCHICONNECT, Friendship

THE department of architecture at North South University has recently signed two memorandums of understanding with Friendship and ARCHICONNECT.

The event was graced by Professor Abdul Hannan Chowdhury, vice-chancellor of NSU, and led by Ar Shahriar Iqbal Raj, associate professor and chairperson of the department of architecture, said a press release on Wednesday.

This was the first official MoU signing that established collaborative partnerships between NSU and ARCHICONNECT as well as Friendship.
