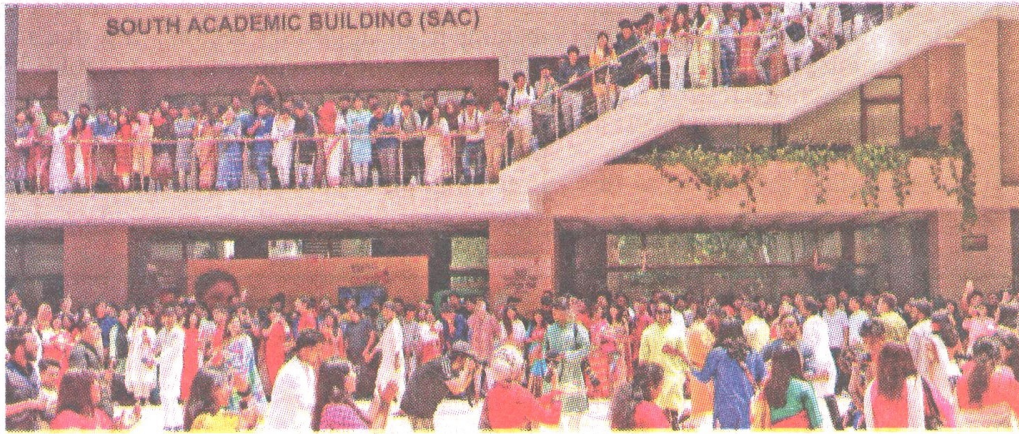


NSU celebrates Bangla New Year 1431 thru cultural programme, Baishakhi Mela
