NSU confers degrees to 3,322 students at 26th convocation

North South University (NSU) awarded degrees to 3,322 students, including 2,646 undergraduates and 676 postgraduates, at its 26th Convocation on the university campus, on Wednesday.

Education Adviser Prof Dr Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar presided over the programme as the Convocation Chair.

Speaking on the occasion, the adviser said the event not only marks the formal completion of students' academic journey but also the beginning of greater responsibilities ahead.
